This application has been preferred seeking placing on record the promotion orders dated 04.06.2026 issued in various subjects as Annexures P-17 to P-30.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, learned State counsel accepts notice with an advance copy. He has not opposed the acceptance of Annexures P-17 to P-30 on record.

Accordingly, the application is allowed and the Annexures P-17 to P-30 i.e. promotion orders are ordered to be taken on record subject to just exceptions. Exemption is granted as prayed for.

This application has been moved before this Court seeking stay of the operation and implementation of the promotion orders dated 04.06.2026. In fact, the learned Senior counsel would contend that the

aforesaid promotion orders are against the mandate of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.1385-2025 titled '*Anjuman Ishaat-e-Taleem Trust vs. State of Maharashtra*' vide judgment dated 01.09.2025. He has also drawn the attention of this Court to a communication made by the Director, School Education (Secondary, Punjab) which discusses the promotion of master cadre due to PSEB referring to Clause 1 wherein it categorically stipulates that subject-wise promotions which are to be made for non-teaching/ETT to master cadre shall be considered only if the candidates are found eligible in all respects with the cut-off date also referred therein as 02.06.2025.

Notice of the application.

Mr. Satnam Preet Singh Chauhan, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for some time to file reply in the application on the date already fixed.

In the meanwhile, the promotion orders dated 04.06.2026 (Annexure P-17 to P-30) if not implemented as on date, shall be kept in abeyance till the next date of hearing.

At this stage, Ms. Neesh Garg, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents (left out teachers) and has filed her vakalatnama. The same is taken on record. Reply, if any, be also filed by the learned counsel on the next date of hearing.
